<p>The following information is requested:</p> <ul style="list-style-type: none"> • A detailed plan for the location and design of the landfill, water storage reservoir and quarry, showing all infrastructure connections (gas, electricity, water, leachate pipeline) and access roads. • Details of any amenities or offices/workshops etc to be located at the wharf or pulp warehouse. • Clarification is requested as to whether the quarry is to have its own office/workshop/toilets/water supply etc or whether the quarry will utilise the facilities being installed at the landfill site. • Previous layout changes provided by Gunns refer to the pulp warehouse being an 'expanded building' on the pulp mill plant site. Details of this new, larger building are requested. • Clarification is requested as to what quantity of the chips stored in GMt/yr at the chip mill site will be produced by the 3 chippers on-site and how much will be imported from other chip mills. Quantities and sources should be detailed. 	<ul style="list-style-type: none"> • See Attached • Office with toilet located adjacent to chemical storage tanks at wharf. Sewage pumped back to effluent treatment plant. See Attached • Temporary facilities will be used and sewage stored and removed. Temporary office will be used. No workshop at this location. • See Attached <p>On-site storage capacity is 350,000 GMT.</p> <p>Production capacity at the site will be 4.5M GMT.</p> <p>It is expected that a minimum 150,000 GMT of hardwood chips will be sourced in chip form (largely from Gunns Launceston mills). The total volume of wood brought into the site in chip form will vary depending on the availability of chips from other sawmills, and the amount of pine pulp being produced (as most pine will be delivered in chip form).</p>
