Behaviour

The below conduct will result in a visit being cancelled or a visit ban:

- Trafficking of any unauthorised items or contraband (including attempts or evidence to establish an attempt is being arranged)
- Inappropriate conduct of a sexual nature
- Threatening or abusive language/ behaviour
- Continued failure to follow directions from staff
- Conduct considered a threat to the safety and security of the prison
- A breach or suspected breach of a protective order (zoom)



Rules

- Any tampering with or damage to clothing will result in the visit ending
- Everyone must remain in their allocated seating for the duration of the visit
- A hug and/ or kiss at the start and end of a contact visit session is allowed.
- Please ensure you use the toilet before your visit. Use of the toilet during a visit will result in the visit being changed to a non-contact or cancelled.

Children

- Children must not be held by prisoners
- Books and toys can be used at the visit table but must be returned to the play area at the end of the visit
- The changing of a nappy will result in the visit being changed to a non-contact or cancelled
- Parents/ guardians must provide an appropriate level of supervision to their children during visits.



Warning

Staff may terminate a visit session if either the visitor or the prisoner/ remandee are not adhering to these requirements. However, in most instances, staff will issue a warning prior to termination.
