

## Conflict Of Interest Declaration For CPC Services

A conflict declaration is required for service providers (including individuals) to provide counselling to eligible persons for the Department of Justice's Approved Counselling Referral Scheme.

Where a service provider is an individual who is or has been associated with an organisation or a related entity of an organisation that has been responsible for child sexual abuse - the association must be disclosed. An association with an organisation includes but is not limited to employees, members, office holders and volunteers.

The existence of a potential conflict of interest may mean that you are not eligible for registration to provide CPC services to Tasmanian survivors.

### Declaration

*I, do solemnly and sincerely declare and affirm, that:*

1. I have read and understood this document;
2. I do not have a conflict of interest in providing CPC services under the Approved Counselling Referral Scheme;
3. I have used my best endeavours, and taken all reasonably practicable steps to ensure I do not have a conflict of interest;
4. I will inform the Department of Justice immediately if a conflict of interest arises or becomes apparent whilst I am registered to provide CPC services;
5. I acknowledge that the existence of a conflict of interest may result in ineligibility for registration or deregistration.
6. I acknowledge that a failure to declare a conflict of interest may result in deregistration.

Each conflict is assessed individually and confidentially, on a case-by-case basis. If you believe that you may have a conflict of interest, please provide the details in writing.
