

## Can I apply to pay by instalments?

**Yes you can.** Contact Monetary Penalties Enforcement Service on 1300 366 776.

You should apply for a variation of payment conditions as soon as you get a court fine or infringement notice if you know you can't pay in full by the due date.

In most cases your application can be dealt with over the phone. However if you owe a large amount of money you may have to submit a written application outlining your financial situation and include supporting documentation.

If you cannot pay because you are experiencing genuine hardship, call today to discuss your options.

Remember, if you ignore the original notice it will cost you more money and may cause you serious inconvenience!

# GOT A FINE? don't let it cost you more

## If you have received a court fine or infringement notice don't ignore it!

Failure to deal with your monetary penalty within 28 days of issue will result in enforcement action to recover the amount owed.

If you are unable to pay within the time allowed you may make application to vary your payment conditions.

## Remember – you have 28 days to comply with the conditions stated on the infringement notice or court fine!

Failure to pay in full or in accordance with an agreed repayment plan will result in the issue of an enforcement order. This will increase the amount and may lead to further enforcement action.



## What happens if I receive an enforcement order and still don't do anything?

If you do not comply with the conditions of an enforcement order sanctions will be imposed increasing the amount owed.

## What sanctions can be imposed?

- Suspension of driver licence
- Suspension of vehicle registration
- Register a charge over land
- Seizure and sale of assets
- Redirection of wages or savings
- Imprisonment

### How can my licence or registration suspension be removed?

By paying your monetary penalties in full or in accordance with an agreed repayment plan.
