I am writing to make a submission to the review of the Tasmanian Planning Commission (TPC). Please consider my points of concern in the review process, as follows:

- 1) That any changes to the TPC do not effect it's crucial role as an independent decision-maker and advisor.

- 3) That the TPC maintains it's responsibility for recommendations in policy development.
