**A fixed disclosure threshold of \$1,000, to be calculated cumulatively
over a whole party group and indexed each full
election according to ABS inflation figures.**



**Online, continuous real-time disclosure to the Australian Electoral
Commission on a publically available website of
donations to political parties, candidates and associated
entities;**

**Public funding of election campaigns like the Commonwealth and
other States;**

**A cap on expenditure for individual candidates and parties in House of
Assembly elections;**

**Corresponding regulation of the political activities of third parties and
associated entities;**

A donation cap of \$3,000 aggregate per donor, per parliamentary term; and

Banning donations from all corporate donors. At a minimum limiting to \$1000 per year donations from property developers, tobacco, liquor and gaming industries be banned. I also support banning donations from foreign interests.
