To whom it may concern,

I wish to submit my opposition to the Workplaces (Protection from Protesters) Amendment Bill 2021 (the draft Bill).

I was a Liberal voter but I do not vote for Liberal anymore as I continually see business interests overriding social, health, education and environmental interests. I am not a protester nor have I been involved in or attended political rallies or been a part of 'action' groups. I have never written letters or submissions for political reasons before.
