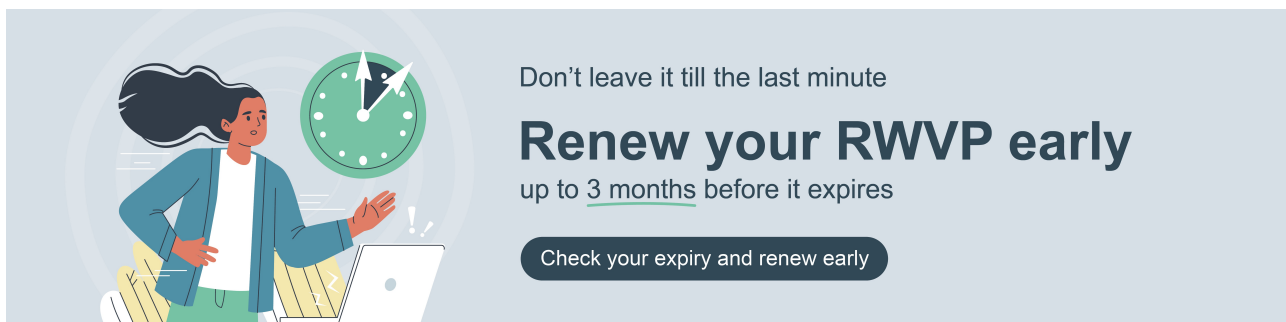

Encourage your workers and volunteers to renew their RWVP early

Do your workers or volunteers need to renew their Registration to Work with Vulnerable People (RWVP) in 2026?

We're halfway through the year, but there are still thousands of workers and volunteers who need to renew their RWVP (around 50,000 across 2026 in total!). These high volumes mean it may take longer than the usual 6 weeks for renewals to be processed. Leaving their renewal to the last minute means workers and volunteers run the risk their RWVP may expire.

This creates real risks to your business operations.



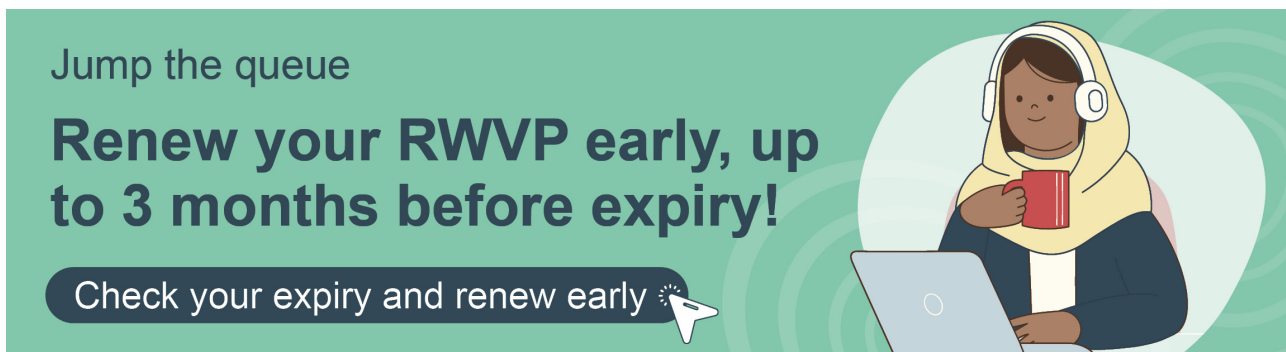
What you can do

Employers and volunteer organisations play an important role! Encourage your workers and volunteers to renew up to 3 months before their RWVP expires.

Being proactive means they'll keep their RWVP active – and you'll avoid disruptions to your business operations.

You can use the RWVP Employer Portal to see when your workers' RWVPs expire, so you can encourage them to renew early.

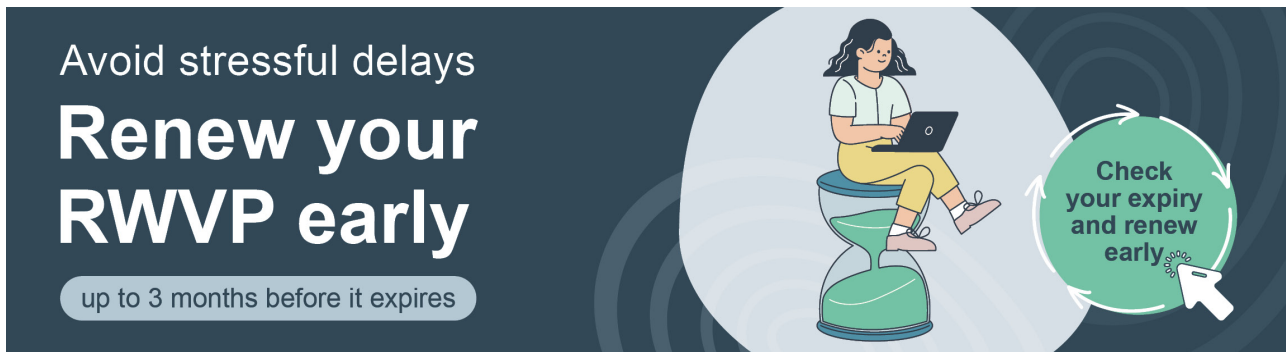
Use our RWVP renewal resources

How your workers and volunteers can renew their RWVP early

It's so easy for your workers and volunteers to:

- check their RWVP card to see when it expires
- make sure they have current proof of identity documents
- jump onto MyRWVP and renew early.

They can renew your RWVP up to 3 months before it expires. Their renewed RWVP will take effect from the date their current RWVP expires. They will get reminders by email and/or text.

And they can now renew their RWVP completely online. After starting their renewal at MyRWVP, if they have the right identity documents they can renew your RWVP completely online, with no need to visit a Service Tasmania service centre! If they are using their current driver's licence, Australian passport, and RWVP card, and they are all in the same name, then they can download the new myServiceTas app to verify their identity. Renewal is easy, and done completely online!

Of course, they can still go to a Service Tasmania service centre. They can book an appointment at Service Tasmania's Hobart and Launceston service centres, and walk-in services are available at all Service Tasmania service centres. Find
