- publicly fund election campaigns

- cap the expenditure of candidates to avoid elected office becoming the preserve of the rich

- the annual threshold for disclosure of donations be lowered to \$1000
- no donor or their affiliates can donate in excess of \$3000 in the life of a parliament
- the identity of the donor and the amount donated (greater than \$1000) be made immediately available to the electorate.
- laundering of political donations through entities associated with political parties be made a criminal offence
