You must supply a least 3 forms of current identity.

At least one document must contain your current residential address.

- Two documents from category 3 and one from category 1 or 2.

Documents provided as proof of identity may be verified through the National Document Verification service (DVS). Documents issued by this office may also be verified by other organisations using DVS.
